Rules and Regulations

1. Concession booth spaces rental is \$50.00 a day non-refundable and a donation item valued of at least \$50.00 daily for the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe Powwow raffle.
2. All vendors are responsible for furnishing their own equipment, tables, chairs, electrical cords, water hoses and generators. You may not plug into the light pole at any time due to tripping hazard the cords may cause.
3. All Vendor spaces must be paid in full before setup, there are no exceptions.
4. Vehicles shall not be parked within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant or fire department connection or fire protection control valve. A minimum of 36" of clear space must be maintained SEC. 16.36.080(17) SCC.
5. Pets are allowed, however, they must be on a leash at all times and pet owners must clean up after their pets.
6. FOOD HANDLERS CARDS REQUIRED AND MUST BE DISPLAYED IN A PROMINENT PLACE ON THE BOOTH, THIS WILL BE CHECKED
7. No vehicles will be allowed into the dance area or in the food vending areas other than transport vehicles.
8. Vendors must have fire extinguishers with a minimum rating of 2 A 10 BC.
9. Propane for heating or cooking is not allowed inside of any building or tent unless properly installed, per the Uniform Fire Code or the Uniform Mechanical code. SEC. 8203.2.1 & SEC. 6105.3 UFC
10. Any Portable Compressed Gas Tanks must be secured against accidental dislodgement and against access by unauthorized personnel. SEC. 7401.6.1 UFC.
11. EXITS- THROUGHOUT. All exits must be unobstructed at all times. Displays, decorations, or other materials or merchandise shall not be placed within the required width of an exit, nor shall the access to any exit be obstructed by unauthorized personnel. Sec. 7401.6.1 UFC.
12. Vendors are responsible for their own property, at all times.

13. **Set-up time will be no earlier than 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, prior to start of Powwow.**
14. Sauk-Suiattle Powwow Committee has the exclusive right to sell items both official and otherwise that might bear the tribal logo or statement "Sauk-Suiattle Powwow" and no artist or vender will be permitted to sell such items.
15. Vendors relieved all Sauk-Suiattle Powwow Committee Representatives of any/ all liability. Sauk-Suiattle Powwow Committee members and the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe are not responsible for accidents or theft. Decisions of the Sauk-Suiattle Powwow Committee are final.
