August 23-25, 2024 Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe Celebration of Generations Pow-Wow Vendor Form

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Concession booth spaces for three days are \$200.00; Craft booth space for three days are \$200.00
- 2. All vendors are responsible for furnishing their own equipment, tables, chairs, electrical cords, generators (Diesel is not allowed), and water hoses.
- 3. Any vendor that cooks food that produces grease laden vapors must utilize a cooking surface with a hood and duct ventilation. The hood and duct must be provided with an automatic fire extinguishing system that has been serviced within the last year.
- 4. All vendor spaces must be paid in full before set-up, there are no exceptions. Anyone who sets up before they check in could be asked to move.
- 5. FOOD HANDLER CARDS REQUIRED AND MUST BE DISPLAYED IN PROMINET PLACE ON THE BOOTH, this will be checked.
- 6. Vehicles shall not be parked within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant or fire department connection or fire protection control valve. A minimum of 36" of clear space must be maintained Sec. 16.36.080(17) SCC.
- 7. No vehicles will be allowed into the dance area or in the food vending area other than transport vehicles.
- 8. Concession vendors must have **fire extinguishers** with a minimum rating of 2 A 10 BC. Craft vendors are recommended to also have a fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 2 A 10 BC.
- 9. Propane for heating or cooking is not allowed inside of any building or tent unless properly installed per the Uniform Fire Code or the Uniform Mechanical code. Sec. 8203.2.1 & Sec. 6105.3 UFC
- 10. Any portable compresses gas tanks must be secured against accidental dislodgment and against access by unauthorized personal. Sec. 7401.6.1 UFC
- 11. EXITS- THROUGHOUT. All exits must be unobstructed at all times. Displays, decorations, or other materials or merchandise shall not be placed within the required width of a exit, nor shall the access to any exit be obstructed by unauthorized personnel. Sec. 7401.6.1 UFC
- 12. Vendors are responsible for their own property, at all times.
- 13. Set-Up time will be no earlier than 9:00 am on Friday, August 23, 2024.
- 14. Sauk-Suiattle Pow wow Committee has the excusive right to sell items both Official and otherwise that might bear the Tribal logo or statement "Sauk-Suiattle Celebration of Generations Pow wow 2024" and no artist or vendors will be permitted to sell such items
- 15. Vendors relieve all Sauk-Suiattle Pow wow committee representatives of any/all liability. Sauk-Suiattle Pow wow committee members and the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe are not responsible for accidents or theft. Decisions of the Sauk-Suiattle Pow wow committee are final.
