Arts & Crafts Vendor Form**

**Rules and Regulations**

- Arts & Craft booth spaces for three days and required a donation item valued of at least \$100.00 to the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe Pow-wow event raffle.
- All vendors are responsible for furnishing their own equipment, tables, chairs, electrical cords, water hoses, and generators.
- Limited generators will be available for a rental fee of \$100.00. You will be responsible for your own fuel. **“LIMITED ELETRICITY AVAILBLE”**
- **All Vendor spaces must be paid in full before setup, there are no exceptions. Anyone who sets up before they check in will be asked to move**
- Vehicles shall not be parked within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant or fire department Connection or fire protection control valve. A minimum of 36” of clear space must be maintained Sec. 16.36.080(17) SCC.
- Pets are allowed, however; they must be on a leash at all times and pet owners must clean up after their pets.
- No vehicles will be allowed into the dance area or in the food vending areas other than transport vehicles.
- Vendors must have fire extinguishers with a minimum rating of 2 A 10 BC.
- Propane for heating or cooking is not allowed inside of any building or tent unless properly installed, per the Uniform Fire Code or the Uniform Mechanical code. Sec. 8203.2.1 & Sec. 6105.3 UFC.
- Any Portable compressed Gas Tanks must be secured against accidental dislodgement and against access by unauthorized personnel. Sec. 7401.6.1 UFC.
- EXITS – THROUGHOUT. All exits must be unobstructed at all times. Displays, decorations, or other materials or merchandise shall not be placed within the required width of a exit, nor shall the access to any exit be obstructed by unauthorized personnel. Sec. 7401.6.1 UFC.

- Vendors are responsible for their own property, at all times.
- Set –up time will be no earlier than 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, July 30, 2015.
- Sauk-Suiattle Pow-wow Committee has the exclusive right to sell items both official and otherwise that might bear the tribal logo or statement “Sauk-Suiattle Pow-wow 2015” and no artist or vendors will be permitted to sell such items.
- Vendors relieve all Sauk-Suiattle Pow-wow Committee Representatives of any/all liability. Sauk-Suiattle Pow-wow Committee members and the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe are not responsible for accidents or theft. Decisions of the Sauk-Suiattle Pow-wow Committee are final.
